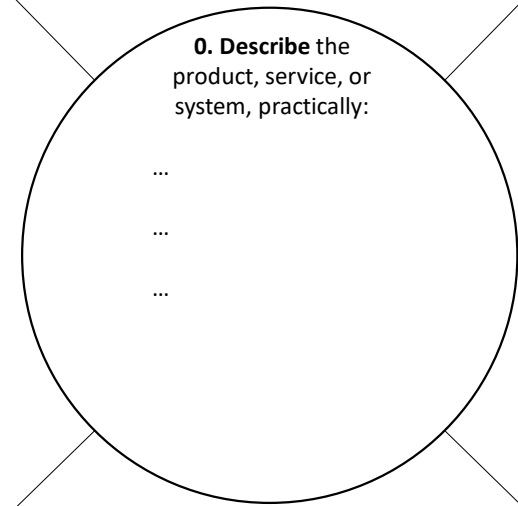


- 4. Virtue ethics, how to live well together**
- Which virtues are relevant, at stake, at risk?
 - E.g., courage, self-control, justice
 - How can people cultivate these virtues?
 - Virtues that you would need to cultivate

- 3. Relational ethics, interactions and power**
- Effects on interactions and on abilities to connect to others and to nature?
 - Effects on distributions of power
 - Between people, between groups



- 1. Consequentialism, outcomes, impacts**
- Potential positive outcomes, benefits?
 - Potential negative outcomes, costs, risks?
 - Where are the analysis' boundaries?
 - Distribution of plusses and minuses

- 2. Duty ethics, human dignity and autonomy**
- Duties, on the side of the organization?
 - Rights, of users / those affected by it?
 - Balance conflicting duties and rights
 - Relevant legislation? E.g., for privacy

- Organize an iterative process**
- Identify issues, e.g., a handful
 - Organize a series of dialogues
 - Make decisions and try-out
